A quote regarding the chlorine building that needs to be constructed to protect the Wells in the amount of \$22,787.

Councilmember Rose Bradford asked if Precision Integrated Systems would be constructing the building. Public Works Director Ramon Camacho explained they would be doing the construction because the building is custom built.
